Crab Competition – Points are for a Crab only Competition and do not accumulate for Club Champion, Inshore or Offshore Champion.

#### COMPETITION BOUNDARIES

- The Northern Boundary is a line east west from the Northern tip of Fraser Island, coordinates 24.70161 S 153.24692 E.
- The Southern Boundary is a line east west from Paradise Caves on the southern side of the Noosa Headland coordinates 26.3954 S 153.1169 E including the Noosa River.
- Tidal waters only, no land locked waters or dams.
- Fishing within green zones or outside of the specified boundaries will result in disqualification.

Note - In the event of bad weather boundaries may be changed prior to the start of the competition at the discretion of the Management Committee.
